

Home Learning Weeks 1 & 2

Age Range: Year 1

Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)	Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Play on Hit the Button - number bonds, halves, doubles and times tables.• Practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. This game could support this.• Work on a shopping list for the weekly shop and get children to add up how many items and add up the cost of some items. This game could support work on making amounts of money.• Practise telling the time. This could be done through this game (scroll down to access the game). Read to the hour and half hour.• Write the numbers 0-20 in words and digits.• Practise your calculations – adding and subtracting and finding the missing number in a sum.• Practise your number formation, writing digits the right way round.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Read a variety of books at home. Your child could share a book everyday. This can be reading a book aloud everyday or sharing a book with an adult.• Listen to a story, Storytime.• Create a bookmark, perhaps you could choose characters from your favourite stories.• Complete a book review on one of the books you have read - what did you like about it? Would you recommend it to anyone?• Comprehension – answer questions about the book you have read.
Weekly Phonics/Spellings Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)	Weekly Writing Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Daily phonics - practise sounds and blends from phases 2-5.• Read and write pseudo (alien) and real words using sounds and blends from your phonics mats.• Interactive games found on links below.• Phonics play• Top Marks• Spelling• Spelling City• Spell the days of the week.• Read and spell common exception words (see sheet)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Take a look at a variety of poems with your child. Ask them to pick their favourite poem and write a poem https://www.poetry4kids.com/topic/family/• Write a letter or postcard from space.• Ask your child to write a space adventure story? Who will be the main characters? What will happen to them?• Practise your sentence writing. Use capital letters, full stops, question and exclamation marks correctly.• Design a planet. Write about who lives there? What is on your planet? Etc• Practise your letter formation – lower case and capitals.
Learning Project - Space	
<p>Produce your own project about Space. Your project should include:- writing, pictures and research.</p> <p>The project this week aims to provide opportunities for your child to gain a better understanding of space and the planets. Learning may focus on the solar system, moon landings and famous astronauts.</p> <p>Art and craft – You could...</p> <p>Make your own solar system 3D model.</p> <p>Make a rocket or flying saucer.</p> <p>Produce a space picture.</p> <p>Design and draw your own alien.</p>
