Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)	Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)
<ul style="list-style-type: none">Complete one Purple Mash Maths task set in your 'Alerts'https://uk.ixl.com/ is an online maths (and reading) site. You don't need a membership as it allows you to do 10 free questions each day. Scroll down to find the appropriate Year group then choose what skill you want to practise.Take One Number Select a number – it can be as big or as small as you want. Now explore what you can do with that number? Can you double it? Halve it? Add or subtract 1 or 10 or 100 or more to it? Multiply it by 10 or 100? Draw it? Show it in different ways?Fractions with Smarties (or other colourful sweets). Tip out a packet of Smarties and sort them by colour. How many statements can you make using fractions? You could count $\frac{1}{2}$ or $\frac{1}{4}$ of your packet. What fraction of your sweets is yellow? Or red?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">You could share a story together. This could be a chapter book where you read and discuss a chapter a day.Read to an adult and discuss what you have read. Remember to read with expression!Interview a Character Write a list of questions that you would like to ask a character. Think about what their answers might be. Now write the interview. For a real challenge, you could work with someone at home and act out the interview.TV Advert Plan and record a TV advert for something you have read. Think about how you will use words and pictures to persuade your audience to buy the product. Now try filming your advert using a tablet or phone.

<ul style="list-style-type: none">Practise the Year 3/4 for Common Exception words.Complete one spelling quiz on Purple Mash in your 'Alerts' section.Vocabulary Hunt Look out for new and interesting words that you come across in your reading. How could you record these? You could make a vocabulary book, a word poster, a personal dictionary, a word wall.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Complete one GaPS 'Alert' on your Purple Mash account.Film Review Sit back and watch a film (perhaps with your family and popcorn) and then write a review. Remember to give the main details, to give an honest opinion about what you thought and perhaps who might enjoy the film. Don't spoil the story though!Take a Picture Using either something you have at home, the view through your window or pobble365.com/ Do a piece of writing inspired by the image. Use all five sense and include as much detail as you can.
