### Year 4

Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)	Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Complete one Purple Mash Maths task set in your 'Alerts'</li><li>• Set up a Times Table relay race. Can you run the lengths of a space and count in your times tables forwards and backwards?</li><li>• <b>Time and Duration</b> Keep a log of all you do for several hours. Record the time when you start and finish each activity. Can you draw these times on a clock face? Can you work out, in hours or minutes, how long you spent doing different tasks during the day?</li><li>• <a href="https://uk.ixl.com/">https://uk.ixl.com/</a> is an <b>online maths</b> (and reading) site. You don't need a membership as it allows you to do 10 free questions each day. Scroll down to find the appropriate Year group then choose what skill you want to practise.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Read to an adult and discuss what you have read. Remember to read with expression!</li><li>• <b>Travel Brochure</b> Choose a story you have read with an interesting setting and create a travel brochure for that place. It could be a real location or an imaginary one. What details can you include? Maybe begin with a map, tourist attractions and shops.</li><li>• <b>Cover</b> Think about all the things that have to be included on a book cover and design (and make) a new cover for a favourite book. What will be on the front? How will you make it eye-catching? As well as the blurb, what else will you put on the back cover?</li></ul>
Spelling Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)	Writing Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Practise the Year 3/4 for <a href="#">Common Exception</a> words.</li><li>• Complete one spelling quiz on Purple Mash in your 'Alerts' section.</li><li>• <b>Alphabetical order:</b> List each letter of the alphabet. Can you think of a <b>sport</b> related word that corresponds with each letter?</li><li>• Proofread writing tasks from this week. Can you use a <a href="#">dictionary</a> to check any spellings that you're unsure of using the first 2/3 letters of the word?</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Complete one GaPS 'Alert' on your Purple Mash account.</li><li>• <b>Write to an author</b> Who is your favourite author? Who wrote your favourite book? Write to them. Tell them why you like what they write. You can find contact details online – either their own website or try sending letters via their publishers.</li><li>• <b>Synonyms and Antonyms</b> Play some games that help develop vocabulary skills. Choose a word and write down as many synonyms as you can. You might use a thesaurus to help. You can play similar games but write down antonyms instead. Try using the words in some silly sentences.</li></ul>
Creative Tasks - to be done throughout the week	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Acts of Kindness</b> – Think of an act of kindness you can complete which will support your family and make them smile. Maybe tidying your room, helping with the gardening, offering to help make a meal.</li><li>• <b>Let's Create</b> - Think of your favourite animal and create a piece of art work to represent it. You could draw, paint, make a collage or even make a model of it. You might find a drawing tutorial online or you might choose to focus on particular patterns or colours that relate to that animal.</li></ul>	



**Time to Talk** - Why not take this time to get to know your family a bit better? You could create a quiz and ask about favourite foods, colours, places, memories, hobbies etc. You could even Facetime other relatives and find out about them too!

- **Keep Moving** - You could have a go at creating your own fitness work out with different activities. Or you could create an obstacle course for your family.
