Weekly Reading Tasks

Monday- You can listen to a free audiobook during your day [here](#). Maybe have a go at listening to a chosen book during a daily walk. How did it make you feel listening to a book in nature?

Tuesday- Using this [‘History of Transport’](#) link, research about all the different types of transport from the past. Make notes as you will need this to complete today's writing task.

Wednesday- Using [‘Taking Flight’](#) on The Literacy Shed, watch the video about a young boy and his Grandpa. Think about the 5Ws - Who, What, Where, When, Why whilst you watch.

Thursday- Comparing transport then and now. Use this [link](#) to look at transport from the Victorian era. How has transport changed to what we know now?

Friday- Challenge - complete an author study of one of your favourite authors. Can you create a list of their famous books and tick the ones you have read? Can you learn enough about the author to write a biography of their life?

Weekly Writing Tasks

Monday- Famous transport - Are there any examples of famous transport you could write about? Ideas to think about: [Titanic](#), [Orient Express](#), [Concord](#), [HMS Victory](#).

Tuesday- Choosing a theme - road, rail, water, air, space, create a poster all about the history of this piece of transport from years ago. You could make comparisons to how this type of transport has evolved over the years.

Wednesday- Linking in with today's video - ‘Taking Flight’, scroll down on [this](#) piece of work until you get to the Kennings poem. What do you think the Kennings is about? Have a go at creating your own and see if a family member
