Writing task 3: Lledr Hall recount

Log onto iXL or MathsWatch daily

Can you remember our school residential to Lledr Hall back in October? I bet you do 😊 What do you remember about it? Is it the activities you did? Travelling there on the coach? How you felt? The scenery? Funny things that happened...

Your task over the next two weeks is to write a recount about your school residential to Lledr Hall. This memory can then be included in your leavers book.

This week I would like you to think about the content you want to include, plan what you want to say, consider what makes a good recount and start to write. (Next week I expect you to finish writing, edit and publish.)

Start by allowing yourself time to recall your trip. What comes to mind? Make a mind map which will help populate your plan and writing. Don't forget to include your feelings and emotions. Maybe you were anxious about staying away from home or completing the Fisherman's Walk. Maybe Lledr Hall is an experience you will never forget because it was amazing!

Next, start to think about what makes a good recount. Record your own success criteria and use it throughout your writing to help you write successfully. Don't forget to think about the writing voice needed for a recount - who is your audience? What is the purpose? Remember to write in the past tense because this experience has happened and writing in chronological order is recommended.

When you are ready to write, keep referring to your plan and success criteria. Find a suitable/comfortable place to work and put pen to paper...
